Recovery Working of MGC's Electronic Materials Subsidiary

This is a brief report on the most recent status of recovery operations at Electrotechno Co., Ltd. (Nishishirakawa-gun, Fukushima), the MGC electronic materials production subsidiary affected by the major earthquake that struck off the east coast of Eastern Japan on March 11, 2011:

The earthquake has caused damage to part of the interior of the Electrotechno buildings and to some equipment; however, power and gas supplies have now been restored.

Since Monday, March 14, Electrotechno management and staff have been working with construction experts to conduct a close inspection of its buildings and equipment, while at the same time making every effort to restore operations. On the basis of information obtained during this inspection, MGC will announce its outlook for the restoration of Electrotechno on Friday, March 18.

At present, MGC estimates that product supply from Electrotechno will be hindered for the immediate future, but it is committed to making every effort to restore production as soon as possible. Further reports will be provided as soon as more information becomes available.
