Recovery Work at MGC's Electronic Materials Subsidiary (The 3rd Report)

The current status as of March 22, 2011 with regard to recovery operations at Electrotechno Co., Ltd. (Nishishirakawa-gun, Fukushima), MGC's electronic materials production subsidiary, is reported as follows:

As was announced in the 2nd Report, released March 18, Electrotechno Co., Ltd. will start partial production in early April as the 1st step of its restoration plan, and is now making every effort to reestablish our product supply system. We set the goal of restoring production to 1/4 of pre-earthquake levels during this 1st step. For that reason we will focus on major items used for semiconductor packages substrate for mobile devices.

The 2nd step of recovery is currently under consideration and will be announced at the end of March.

Problems with logistics or the purchase of raw materials due to the impact of the earthquake may force changes in the above-mentioned plans.

Recovery work has not been adversely affected by the situation at the Fukushima nuclear power plant.
